



ESLAV Board Policy

ESLAV is an important voice for veterinarians in the field of animal research. ESLAV is grateful to members who volunteer to work for the society and as such want to have a broad representation of Board members to include people from different countries of the world and from different backgrounds and industries.

The ESLAV Board has monthly teleconference meetings which usually last one hour. There are two face-to-face meetings per year.

Travel

The ESLAV Board has a modest travel and accommodation policy.

The Spring face-to-face meeting and any other meeting activity where ESLAV representation is expected will be covered by ESLAV, if board members travel in economy or for the lowest fare and stay one night at a hotel of reasonable standard. Additional nights may be permitted if travel connections are not possible or if the travel costs would be reduced or would be lower.

The second face-to-face meeting of the year is organised in connection with the Annual Scientific Event and AGM. Usually, Board members will participate under the expenses of their employer, however, in the circumstance that the employer will not cover the costs, they will be covered by ESLAV following an application to the Honorary Treasurer who will bring it to the Board for discussion and agreement.

For local travel, public transport is preferred. Alternatively, a taxi or cab may be used.

Expenses

All expenses will be reviewed and approved by the Honorary Treasurer. Expenses must be reasonable and justified and made in accordance with the interests of ESLAV, for ESLAV business.

Expenses must be submitted within three months of the date of the expense.
